- Children are offered a daily drink of milk or water during their sessions but can bring in their own bottles of plain water if they so wish. This MUST be plain water due to health and safety/allergies.
- Any money for fees needs to be handed to Carmella in the office between 8.30 and 2.30pm please.

If the weather does improve (fingers crossed!) then please send your child to nursery wearing appropriate sun protection cream and with a sun hat/cap to keep them safe in the sun. We will send out sun cream permission forms for our 30 hours children in due course which will enable staff to reapply sun cream in the afternoon for our all day children.
