- \* For children who bring a packed lunch to school, can we remind parents that grapes need to be cut length ways to ensure that they are not a choking hazard please
- \* Please note— If parents wish for their children to do extra sessions or stay for lunch time provision, then this needs to be booked in advance with Carmella in the office to prevent disappointment. Any money for fees needs to be handed to Carmella in the office between 8.30 and 2.30pm please. Any sessions which are booked in but not attended will still be invoiced and must be paid for.
