Reminders and information

- Can we remind parents that Nursery session times are 8.30-11.15/11.30am and 12.15-3.00/3.15pm. We ask that children are brought in on time so that they do not miss valuable learning with their keyworkers and collected promptly please.
- Children are offered a daily drink of milk or water during their sessions but can bring in their own bottles of plain water only if they so wish. We ask for plain water due to allergies and oral hygiene.
- We welcome donations of fruit for snack time which can be brought in on Mondays for morning groups and Wednesdays for afternoon groups please. This will be used to benefit all of our children for things such as entertainment, food activities and visitors in school
- A voluntary contribution of £1.50 for school fund can be brought in on Mondays and given to keyworkers.
- Can parents please ensure that all belongings are labelled with their child's name, including coats, shoes, lunchboxes and bags.

Please note— If parents wish for their children to do extra sessions or stay for lunch time provision, then this will need to be booked **in advance along with payment** to Carmella in the office to prevent disappointment. Any money for fees needs to be handed to Carmella in the office between 8.30 am and 2.30pm. Please note failure to attend any extra booked sessions are still chargeable as you pay for the space not attendance.
