Dear parents and carers,

A happy new year to you all!

We are now very much back in the swing of things at nursery as we are part way through the first half of the Spring term. Reminders and information

- * Children are offered a daily drink of milk or water during their sessions but can bring in their own bottles of plain water if they so wish. This must be plain water ONLY.
- * Can parents please ensure that all belongings are labelled with their childs name, including coats, shoes, lunchboxes and bags.
- * For children who bring a packed lunch to school, can we remind parents that grapes need to be cut length ways to ensure that they are not a choking hazard please
- * Please note— If parents wish for their children to do extra sessions or stay for lunch time provision, then this needs to be booked in advance with Carmella in the office to prevent disappointment. Any money for fees needs to be handed to Carmella in the office between 8.30 and 2.30pm please.
