Dear Parents and carers of our children returning to Nursery for a second year here at Millfields Nursery school.

I hope you are all well and have managed to enjoy the Summer break. As you will have seen on the News all children are able to return to school.

We are in the process of getting ready to ensure that Millfields is a safe environment for you and your child. This means that we still need to follow very clear guidelines as follows:-

- Staggered start and end times to ensure social distancing
- Regular cleaning of all equipment used.
- Children placed in consistent groups
- Hand gelling and hand washing throughout session and on entrance and exit for both children and adults

With this in mind for now we also need to ensure the following:-

- Children if possible are brought to school and collected by 1 consistent adult
- Children will be brought to the entrance by that adult but will then be encouraged to come into school themselves (with support from the staff)
- Children will be given a drink and snack whilst in school (provided by school) therefore for now we ask that children do not bring in drinks bottles or any food from home.
- Children will not need to bring in a bag with a change of clothes, these can be provided by Nursery if needed, unless your child is in a nappy or pull up in which case they can bring a bag with nappy/pull up/ wipes.

We are looking forward to welcoming you back into school.

On Tuesday 8th September a.m children 9.30-11 am and pm children 1-2.30 pm
From Wednesday 9th September Nursery session times for the foreseeable future will be as follows:-

AM children

Beckie Bradburn, Beckie Queen and Sheila Baileys a.m groups arrival 8.30-8.45 am and collected 11-11.15

Dawn Taylors group arrival 9-9.15 am and collected 11.20-11.30 am

PM children

BB, BQ, SB pm groups arrival 12.15-12.30 and collected 2.45-3pm

Children who access 30 hours of provision arrival 9-9.15 am and collected at 3-3.15pm

Please note it is very important that you stick to the times specified to allow for social distancing and children arriving and departing within their group times.
