Dear Parents and Carers of all Nursery and Toddler Children

We hope you are all keeping well in these unusual and difficult circumstances.

As you may be aware, the guidelines change on a daily basis from the Government. We are in the process of phoning families who we believe may fall into the Government's guidelines on key workers. Children of outlined key workers can essentially come to school.

May we remind you that children coming to school should be avoided where possible in terms of limiting the spread of coronavirus. Therefore, if you have alternative childcare that is suitable ie not with an elderly person over the age of 70, then this would still be our recommendation.

If you believe you fall into the keyworker role and will need childcare and you have not been contacted by the school, please ring the school office to speak to staff to discuss this and clarify the situation.

Provision will be available at Millfields for those identified children from 8.30 to 3.15, Monday to Friday. Please note there will be no additional hours ie breakfast and teatime.
